

YMCA/JCC WEATHER EMERGENCY PLANS

Effective: December 8, 2005

Snow Emergency: (As determined by the county where the Branch or Child Care program is located)

Level I

- YMCA/JCC Child Care will operate as usual. If schools are closed, the full day Child Care sites will be open.
- YMCA/JCC Branches will operate as usual

Level II

- YMCA/JCC Child Care programs may have a two hour delay in opening. Second shift will operate with normal hours.
- YMCA/JCC Branches will operate as usual.

Level III

- The YMCA/JCC Child Care programs and second shift sites will be closed. If a Level III is called during the middle of the day, the center will close early. Every reasonable attempt to contact parents to come pick-up their children from the site will be made. If parents cannot be reached, other emergency contacts will be called. If a Level III is downgraded to a Level II in the middle of the day, YMCA/JCC Child Care will open the next morning.
- YMCA/JCC Branches will close.

Emergency School Closing:

If your child's school has a situation where they must evacuate and close the building in the middle of the day, you will be required to make necessary arrangements to pick him or her up at school. The YMCA/JCC will pull together a staff team to provide care at your full day YMCA/JCC Child Care site in the event of an emergency school closing.

Emergency YMCA Child Care Closing:

If a YMCA/JCC Child Care site must close due to a building or snow emergency, the YMCA/JCC will make every attempt to make care available at an alternative YMCA/JCC Child Care location. YMCA/JCC Child Care Services (419-474-3995) will have updated information
